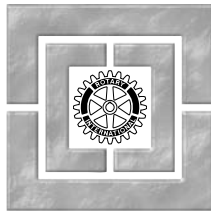

The Board also agreed that those official participants identified above, with the exception of the International PolioPlus Committee chair, officers and officers-nominee of the General Counsel of RIBI, and spouses will not be included in the International Assembly Participants book.

In addition, those official participants identified above who attend the International Assembly at no cost to RI or its Foundation shall be charged a registration fee of US\$65 to cover the administrative expenses involved in their attendance, except the regional magazine editors whose registration fee will be waived.

San Diego

Registration Process

1. Check in at the hotel registration desk.
2. Pick up registration packets between 08:00 and 17:00 hours on Monday, 18 January, at the International Assembly Registration Desk located on the first floor in the Douglas Foyer.
3. After 17:00 hours on Monday, 18 January, registration packets will be in the Assembly Office located on the second floor in Show Management Office #2. The Assembly Office will be open until 20:00 on Monday, 18 January, and will reopen Tuesday, 19 January, starting at 07:00 hours.

Meals

Opening Dinner, International Fellowship Dinner and Dance, and Closing Dinner meal tickets may be available for purchase on-site on a first-come, first-served basis on the major arrival day, Monday, 18 January, only. On-site payments will be accepted in U.S. dollars by credit card or cash only (personal, club, or district checks will not be accepted). Tickets will not be available for the meal plan through RI at the Manchester Grand Hyatt San Diego; however, there are several restaurant options in the area.

Observer Participation

Official participants attending the International Assembly as observers are welcome to attend all plenary sessions, International Festival Talent Night, and the World Affairs Seminar. However, group discussions and Club and District Support sessions are reserved for district governors-elect.

World Affairs Seminar

The World Affairs Seminar is a specialized series of panel discussions that are focused on Rotary's impact and involvement in distinct areas of the world. Spouses of district governors-elect, spouse program facilitators, Rotary senior leaders and spouses, and observers are invited to attend the World Affairs Seminar during the International Assembly.

Solicitation Prohibition

RI prohibits unofficial solicitations for funds. Likewise, the display or distribution of any promotional material, in the plenary hall, group discussion rooms, or elsewhere, without prior written approval of the RI president-elect is strictly prohibited.

Dress Code

During the working part of the day, the appropriate dress is business casual, this includes all plenary sessions, International Festival Talent Night, and the Opening Dinner.

Attendees and their spouses are invited and highly encouraged to wear their national dress for the International Fellowship Dinner and Dance. The evening will begin with a grand march of those participants wearing national dress assembled by country. For those not wearing national clothing, the attire for this event is business dress. The attire for the Closing Dinner is also business dress.

Registration Fee

All official participants attending the International Assembly as observers, with the exception of regional magazine editors, are required to pay a US\$65 per person nonrefundable registration fee. The registration fee includes access to all plenary sessions, an International Assembly Participants Book, International Assembly Program Book, and International Assembly Speeches CD.

Shipping

Participants planning to ship items to the Manchester Grand Hyatt San Diego should make sure to follow the necessary U.S. Customs procedures. Participants should bring copies of all shipping documents to facilitate tracking down their goods, in case a problem would arise at Customs. A handling fee will be charged to the hotel bill for packages received at the Manchester Grand Hyatt San Diego. RI will not reimburse handling fees. Please address shipments in the following manner:
